<u>Analogies</u>: Analogies are comparisons between two sets of things, sharing the same relationship. Look at the example: <u>Cat is to purr as dog is to bark.</u>

The first set of items is cat and purr, and the relationship between them is that "purr" is the noise cats make. That same relationship has to exist in the second set of items, dog and bark. "Bark" is the noise that dogs make.


<u>Comprehension</u>: Answer each question with complete, correctly capitalized and punctuated sentences. Don't forget to underline in the questions.
